### Parking

Kennedyplein is a square that only allows traffic to flow in one direction. Park your car in the public car park of Kennedyplein. Take the stairs or lift up from the car park. You will arrive at a pedestrian area in-between the buildings of Kennedyplein. The Kennedy Tower where you will find Nederlandsch Octrooibureau (Kennedyplein 236) is the highest building on Kennedyplein. Please sign in at the reception desk of the Kennedy Tower.

## Route Description

### Public transport

Nederlandsch Octrooibureau can easily be reached by train. At Eindhoven Central Station take the bus-side exit. Turn right and walk in-between the buildings following signs for the University (TU/e). After approximately 100 m you will find the entrance to the offices of Nederlandsch Octrooibureau on your right, Kennedyplein 236. Please sign in at the reception desk of the Kennedy Tower.

### Situation changed

The traffic situation on the motorways around Eindhoven radically changed in 2010. (GPS) maps from before 2010 cannot be trusted!

### By car

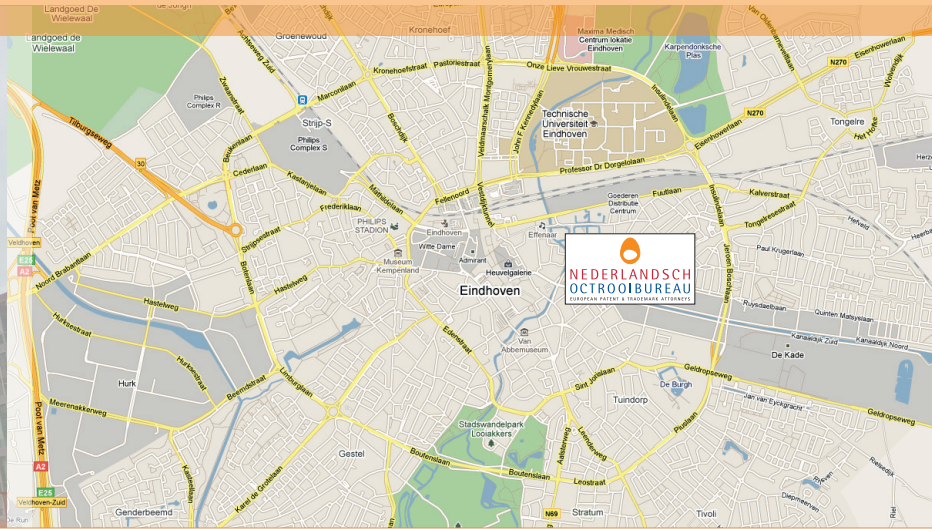
**1. From Tilburg/Breda (A58)** Take the A58 following signs for Eindhoven. When you arrive at the Batadorp junction, follow signs to Helmond/Nijmegen (A50) and further along take the Helmond/Eindhoven-Centrum exit (exit number 6+7). Continue straight when you reach the roundabout (follow the sign for exit 7, Eindhoven-Centrum (Eindhoven City Centre)). The road turns right. You will now be on J.F. Kennedylaan (see below on how you should continue).

**2. From Amsterdam/Utrecht/s Hertogenbosch (A2)** Take the A2 following signs for Eindhoven. When you arrive at the Ekkesweijer (A58/A2) junction, follow signs for Helmond/Nijmegen (A50). Next, take the Helmond/Eindhoven-Centrum (Eindhoven City Centre) exit (exit number 6+7). Continue straight when you reach the roundabout (follow the sign for exit 7, Eindhoven-Centrum). The road turns right. You will now be on J.F. Kennedylaan (see below on how you should continue).

**3. From Nijmegen/Arnhem (A50)** Take the A50 following signs for Eindhoven and take the Eindhoven-Centrum (Eindhoven City Centre)/Kennedylaan exit (exit number 6+7, next, keep left and take exit number 7, Eindhoven-Centrum). You will arrive on J.F. Kennedylaan (see below on how you should continue).

### From J.F. Kennedylaan (Eindhoven North)

Take the J.F. Kennedylaan following signs for Eindhoven-Centrum (Eindhoven City Centre). When you reach the end of J.F. Kennedylaan (at the "Flying Pins" – an engineering work with large yellow bowling pins), take the left lane and continue straight ahead when you reach the intersection (follow signs saying "Park at Kennedyplein"). Park in the car park.

## Route Description

**4. From Helmond (A270)** Continue straight ahead from the A270. Again continue straight ahead when you reach the roundabout (Insulindeplein) (2nd turning). You will now be on Prof Dr. Dorgelolaan. Turn left at the traffic lights in front of the “Flying Pins” (an engineering work with large yellow bowling pins); follow the sign “Park at Kennedyplein”. Park in the car park.

**5. From Venlo (A67)** Take the A67 following signs for Eindhoven until you see signs at the Leenderheide junction for exit 33 (Waalre) and the N2 Randweg (South). Take this ring road (in Dutch randweg). This is an 80 km/h motorway for local traffic that runs parallel to the normal motorway). You will arrive at a roundabout with traffic lights. Turn right following signs for Tongelre. You will now be on Leenderweg (see below on how you should continue).

**6. From Weert/Maastricht (A2)** Take the A2 until you reach the Leenderheide junction. Take the exit for local traffic (N2 ring road (in Dutch randweg)). You will arrive at a roundabout with traffic lights. Continue straight ahead following signs for Tongelre. You will now be on Leenderweg (see below on how you should continue).

**7. From Turnhout (A67)** Take the A67 following signs for Eindhoven. When you arrive at the De Hogt junction, keep to your right and follow signs for the N2/Eindhoven-Centrum/Waalre Randweg (South; randweg means ring road in Dutch). Take this N2 ring road (South) until you arrive at a roundabout with traffic lights. Turn left at the roundabout following signs for Tongelre. You will now be on Leenderweg (see below on how you should continue).

### *From Leenderweg (Eindhoven South)*

Continue straight ahead on Leenderweg. At the next roundabout (Floraplein) again continue straight ahead. At the second set of traffic lights turn right on to the Eindhoven ring road (the Ring is a 70 km/h road around the city centre). Take the ring road until you reach the next roundabout (Insulindeplein). Go around the roundabout three quarters of the way (Prof. Dr. Dorgelolaan) and turn left at the traffic lights in front of the “Flying Pins” (an engineering work with large yellow bowling pins). Follow the sign “Park at Kennedyplein”. Park in the car park.
